

Work Package 4

The interviews will be based on a qualitative, **semi-structured questionnaire** focusing on specific aspects of integration and their explanation that cannot be grasped in the survey. The analysis will follow a grounded-theory approach and qualitative content analysis, making use of Computer-Assisted Qualitative Data Analysis Software (such as ATLAS.ti or MAXQDA).

The in-depth interviews will be **linked to the individual survey** in several ways. On one hand, qualitative interviews will help to contextualize and enrich the results of the standardized survey and to critically discuss and assess hypothesis generated and tested through statistical means. On the other hand, they will allow to dig inductively into the microcosm of young unemployed, here primarily by uncovering the individual perception of the problem of joblessness, the narrative understanding of young people's life-course and their current situation, and by unveiling individual coping strategies in regard to unemployment and to social and political marginalization. Moreover, we will be able to assess ongoing policy-instruments and initiatives from the perspective of addressees
