

Objectives 2

Given the lack of previous systematically comparative surveys of unemployed youth in Europe, a structured and focused database on this group can provide a basis for both scientific explanations of social exclusion in general and policy measures aimed at finding solutions to the social and political exclusion of young unemployed. In order to reach this objective, three kinds of data will be generated by means of three different methods: a survey of organizations working in the field of unemployment, a quantitative survey on a representative sample of young unemployed, and an in-depth qualitative analysis of the situation of jobless youth. This objective and its three main components will be finalized through national and integrated reports on the organizational survey, the individual survey, and the in-depth analysis.
